Federal Election 2016: Multicultural policy commitments from the major parties

Earlier this month, FECCA released <u>Governing for All Australians: A Policy Platform to Respond to Australia's Cultural and Linguistic Diversity</u>. The memorandum outlines FECCA's election asks, recognising that targeted policies are necessary to address the specific needs of Australia's culturally and linguistically diverse (CALD) population, foster social inclusion and to continue attracting migrants.
